Jesus teaches his disciples often about prayer. He shows them how to pray (Matt 6:9-13, Luke 11:2-4). He teaches them that they can ask for anything. (Matt 7:7-8) He also teaches that our heart matters when we pray to God (Matt 6:5-13). And He even teaches that if we are persistent enough in our prayer He will answer (Luke 18:1-7). 
One time when Jesus had finished praying his disciples asked Him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples." So he said to them, "When you pray, say:


Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven.
