

The Beatitudes

Have you ever been so hungry you thought you were going to starve? So thirsty you wanted to drink glass after glass of water? Well, Jesus says that's what we are supposed to be for His word. He tells us in Matthew



5:6 that *Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled.* Let's see how much Zacchaeus hungered and thirsted for righteousness.

Blessed are those who Hunger and Thirst for Righteousness...

If we are hungry and thirsty we are able to just go into the kitchen and get a snack or a drink of water. We usually eat breakfast, lunch and dinner as well as a snack or two during the day. Food is very important to us and when we don't have it, we become hungry. Well, God wants us to Hunger and Thirst (want it as much as we would food or drink) for His word and His teaching, then He will fill us and give us all we need.

Zacchaeus knew exactly what it meant to Hunger for Jesus. Zacchaeus was a tax



collector, un-liked by many of the Jews because many tax collectors were thieves and stole money from the people. He heard that Jesus was coming to his town and Zacchaeus wanted to see Him. So Zacchaeus ran out to see Jesus. But Zac-


chaeus was short and could not see Jesus because of the large crowd. So Zacchaeus ran ahead of the crowd and climbed up into a tree just to get a look at Jesus as He went by. When Jesus came by the tree, he looked up and saw Zacchaeus. Jesus said to Zacchaeus, "Hurry and come down, for I must stay at your house today." So Zacchaeus hurried and came down and received Jesus joyfully.

Many of the Jews were upset that Jesus chose to stay with Zacchaeus, a tax-collector and sinner. But Zacchaeus was joyful and his desire, or Hunger, to see Jesus was fulfilled when Jesus went to his home.


