

The Beatitudes

In our last lesson we learned about the first beatitude, or blessing, that Jesus spoke about in His sermon on the mount in Matthew 5.

The first Beatitude was Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the



kingdom of heaven. We looked at Barnabas and how he put God and others first, just as we should. The next Beatitude is *Blessed are those that mourn, for they shall be com-forted.* Let's learn about Peter, why he mourned and how he was comforted.

Blessed are those that Mourn... (Matt 5:4, Matt 26:69-75, Luke 22:54-62)




When Jesus was arrested, Peter followed them and waited outside the courtyard to see what was going to happen to Jesus. While he was waiting a servant girl asked him if he was with Jesus of Galilee, to which Peter said no, he wasn't. A little later, another girl saw him and said "This man was with Jesus of Nazareth" (V. 71) But Peter became angry and denied it, saying, "I do not know the man." (V. 72)


A third time, someone came up to him and said to Peter, "Certainly you too are one of them, for your accent betrays you." (V. 73) Then he became even angrier and said again, "I do not know the man." (V. 74)

And immediately a rooster crowed and Peter remembered the words Jesus has spoken to him saying, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny me three times." (V. 75) Peter became very sad and went out and wept bitterly.

Peter was sad, or was mourning, because he knew what he had done was wrong. He had sinned, denying Jesus, telling others he did not know Jesus. Peter turned to Jesus, sad, asking His forgiveness.

We can have comfort knowing that when we turn to Jesus, He will always forgive us our sins when we are sad, or mourning, and really sorry for something that we have done wrong like He did Peter.








Blessed are those that Mourn...

Draw happy faces on the children looking to Jesus.








Blessed are those that Mourn ...
