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Parable - The Talents (Matt 25:14-29)

For the last several weeks we have been learning about Parables. A parable is an earthly story with a heavenly meaning. In other words, it's a story that we can easily understand to help explain something more complicated that we may not easily understand. Over the last several weeks we have discussed many parables. We have learned how to be a light, a wise man who built his house on the rock, the rich fool taught us what our priorities should be, and we learned about being a sower and how to hear God's Word. Today's parable teaches us how God wants us to use our talents to serve Him and others.

Jesus told His Disciples this parable:

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 14 "For it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted to them his property. 15To one he gave five talents, to another two, to another one, to each according to his ability. Then he went away.



16He who had received the five talents went at once and traded with them, and he made five talents more. 17So also he who had the two talents made two talents more. 18But he who had

received the one talent went and dug in the ground and hid his master's money.

19Now after a long time the master of those servants came and settled accounts with them. 20And he who had received the five talents came forward, bringing five talents more, saying, 'Master, you delivered to me five talents; here, I have made five




talents more.' 21His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.'



22And he also who had the two talents came forward, saying, 'Master, you delivered to me two talents; here, I have made two talents more.' 23His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.'

24He also who had received the one talent came forward, saying, 'Master, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you did not sow, and gathering where you scattered no seed, 25so I was afraid, and went and hid your talent in the ground. Here, you have what is




yours.' 26But his master answered him, 'You wicked and slothful servant! You knew that I reap where I have not sown and gather where I scattered no seed? 27Then you ought to have invested my money with the bankers, and at my coming I should

have received what was my own with interest. 28So take the talent from him and give it to him who has the ten talents. 29For to everyone who has will more be given, and he will have an abundance. But from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away.

Just like the servants, God has given us talents or abilities. He wants us to use those talents to praise and serve Him, share His word with others and serve those around us. Many of the parables that we have learned about over the last several weeks teach us what are talents are and how we can use them. What are some of your talents and how can you use them to serve God and others?


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




